Application Process

New Students

To apply for financial aid, you must complete these five steps. Failure to complete all steps will delay your receiving financial aid.

STEP 1 Cambridge College Financial Aid Application (page 2). This may be done while you are finishing your admission file.

STEP 2 PIN (Personal Identification Number). To apply for a PIN, go to www.studentloans.gov/ and click on the PIN site. You will need your PIN to sign in to the studentloans.gov/ website and complete all further steps. You will need to provide your name, address, Social Security number and date of birth. You will also select and answer a challenge question. You will receive your PIN in about three to four days by e-mail or postcard. (Do not confuse this PIN with the PIN used to access MyCC.)

STEP 3 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Go to www.studentloans.gov/ and click on FAFSA to complete the 2010-2011 FAFSA form for the current award year. You will need information from your 2009 federal tax return and W-2 forms to complete this application for Summer 2011 financial aid.

*Warning—Do not use any other website or pay a fee!
The federal website is free of charge.*

STEP 4 Entrance Counseling — All new students must complete entrance counseling prior to loans being disbursed to their account. Go to www.studentloans.gov/, sign in, click on Entrance Counseling and follow online instructions.

Entrance counseling is a federal requirement even if you have borrowed at other schools.

STEP 5 Master Promissory Note for the William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan — Go to www.studentloans.gov/, sign in, click on Sign Master Promissory Note, and follow online instructions.

Continuing Students

Continuing students **MUST reapply** every academic year to be considered for continuing financial aid. Only steps 1, 3 and 5 are needed. However, if you have not taken out a federal student loan in prior years at Cambridge College, you will need to complete all steps, as a new student.
